Things to note:

- Please note that the ages on our form are as a guide, please discuss with the program cocoordinator should you want to register for a group not within your child's age group. Accommodations can be made IF spaces are available, and the conductor feels it is an appropriate fit for the child.
- 2. Please chat with your FSCD worker about <u>Developmental Aide</u> or <u>Specialized Respite</u> contracts to help support the cost of the program:
 - a. <u>Developmental Aide</u> funding involves contracts for direct & indirect program time, for co-ordination for our team, and family must be willing to engage in parent training.
 - b. <u>Specialized Respite</u> funding with FACE. Due to the nature of our program being beyond typical respite, requiring specialized staff on site and higher than average staff ratios, we have to charge a monthly **parent portion fee** in addition to the FSCD funding. It will be based on the amount of program hours your child is **registered** for per week. The fees are non-refundable and payable even if absent, unless absence is due to unpreventable hospitalization, such as surgery or emergency ICU/care. Please note that as of September 1st 2018 our fees have increased. Parent Portion fees will be invoiced monthly as follows:

9-10 Hrs/week = \$425 per month

7-8 Hrs/week = \$340 per month

5-6 Hrs/Week = \$250 per month

3-4 Hrs/Week = \$170 per month

2 Hrs/Week = \$85 per month



- 3. Once an FSCD contract is secured and signed, please forward a copy to Abigail (abigail@conductive-education.ca) or bookkeeper@conductive-education.ca.
- 4. For those who are self-paying (not using FSCD funding) or if you run out of FSCD funding, monthly fees are invoiced by email at the <u>end</u> of each month. The rate for Self-pay families will be charged is **\$42.50**/direct program hour.
- 5. Please make cheques payable to FACE. Payment by E-transfer is also available.
- 6. Registrations are based on a first come first registration process. We are currently reserving previously held spots for all children who attended Saturday programs in June. A waitlist is already in place to cover any available spots that become available. Saturday participants are still expected to return this registration.
- 7. Due to the staffing needs of our program, please ensure 24 hours' notice is given for notification of non-attendance.
- 8. Confirmation of your registration into the program will be sent to you one week before program start date.
- 9. NSF (non-sufficient funds) cheques are subject to a \$25 service fee.
- 10. FACE reserves the right to increase program fees with a 30 day notice.
